2013 Budget

The Proposed Budget for 2013 was discussed at the November 2012 board meeting and approved; the quarterly maintenance charge was raised to \$530 to cover anticipated expenses. A reserve account was established for these expenses. Campbell Property Management has sent coupons and mailing envelopes to owners for their use.

A lending library is available in the clubhouse. Please contribute books (fiction or non-fiction). Please, no magazines or newspapers. The books are there for your reading pleasure.




Notices/Reminders

- 1. The irrigation system is old and is under constant maintenance. If you notice that your lawn and/or plants are stressed from lack of water, please notify our Property Manager, Brian Tight of Campbell Property Management, and hand-water your area until repairs can be made. If you notice a missing/damaged sprinkler head, notify Brian.
- 2. Parents are responsible for their children's actions on the property and around the pool and clubhouse.
- Changes in and/or improvements to the outside appearance of your property must be presented to the Architectural Review Committee prior to beginning the work. Forms may be obtained from Campbell Property Management. Any additions to your landscaping are YOUR responsibility to maintain.
- 4. Due to an ongoing problem with *rats* around the property, please DO NOT FEED your pets outside or feed any of the wild critters we see around (squirrels, ducks, birds, etc.). This only invites the continued rat problem in and around our homes.
- 5. Once again, we remind you to pick up after your dogs. This is a Palm Beach County ordinance. The feces are also a health hazard to all. All dogs must be on a leash.



- 6. Attention Landlords: Please make your tenants aware of the Rules and Regulations of Fairway Village. Request that they abide by them and be respectful of your property and that of your neighbors.
- 7. Parking problems are an ongoing issue. Homeowners should keep their vehicles parked in their own driveway or garage. Guest parking spots should be available for visitors.
- 8. Do not park or drive vehicles on the grass. Sprinkler heads, and the grass itself, can be damaged. Over the last year we have spent over **\$600 per month** maintaining our sprinkler system. Added expenses ultimately are paid by the homeowners.
- 9. Do not place trash curbside before 4PM Sundays (for Monday pick up) or 4PM Wednesdays (for Thursday pick up). Please place all garbage and trash in cans. Plastic bags attract rats and squirrels. Monday is recycle day; Thursday is the day for small cuttings.



10. Any workers you employ to do trimming in your yard must remove all plant/tree trimmings. Do not leave these for the Solid Waste Authority to pick up.

11. The Palm Beach County Sheriffs Department has reported an increase in home burglaries and break-ins in this area. Secure all doors and windows of your home. Cars have been broken into and/or stolen. Do not leave valuables in your cars and make sure the cars are locked.
